Prescott Area Shelter Services

Provides shelter and basic resources to homeless/transitional women and children of Yavapai County.

People Who Care

Volunteers provide caring non-medical assistance to adults unable to drive so that they can continue living on their own.

Habitat for Humanity

Brings people together to build homes in communities and hope for low income applicants for home ownership.

Highway Clean up
