Recipients will be announced **Sunday, May 4, 2025**, at the 10:00 am service at St. Luke's Episcopal Church. Scholarship checks will only be made payable to the school following enrollment and must be issued in the year they are awarded.

Eligibility

The student must be a graduating senior attending school or completing an approved GED program in the Quad City area. The student must have applied to and will attend an accredited public or private university, college, or junior college, or will attend a certified vocational or trade school after high school graduation.

Requirements

- A minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 or official proof of a GED certification during the current school year.
- Student must plan to attend an accredited public or private university or college or junior or community college after high school graduation or GED certification.
- Student must answer one of the essay questions.
- Student must complete the application.
- Finalists will be interviewed by Scholarship Committee members.
- Deadline for submission to St. Luke's Episcopal Church is Wednesday, March 5, 2025.

Selection of Scholarship Recipients

St. Luke's independent Scholarship Committee will review all applications and select up to three (3) \$1,000 scholarship winners. Winners will be notified by phone or email the week before the announcement at church so that they can prepare to receive their scholarship awards at the 10:00 am service at St. Luke's on **Sunday, May 4, 2025**. The scholarships will *not* be based on financial need but on the quality of the application, written essay, and interview.

Along with the completed application, the student must also submit:

- Official school transcript with SAT or ACT test scores (if available) or official proof of GED.
- Three (3) letters of recommendation, one of which must be from a school counselor or a teacher. No relatives.
- Verification of acceptance to an accredited public or private university or college or junior or community college.
