Warm for Winter on Wheels

St. Luke's and other churches collect, sort and distribute warm clothing and blankets to those in need during the winter months.

Winter Warm-up

Meals are prepared and served at the Salvation Army for those staying overnight during the winter months in Prescott.

Angel Quilts

Quilters make handmade quilts for children in extreme illness and stress. These small reminders of love help comfort them and feel less afraid.

Weekly Food Collection

Parish members donate nonperishable food items weekly to help keep the community food banks shelves stocked for the hungry.

The food is distributed equally among the three food banks:

Bradshaw Mountain High School Students

Clothing and educational needs are provided for the homeless and unaccompanied minors at the school.

Camp Genesis Chapel Rock

Helping children of incarcerated parents attend Camp Genesis, at Chapel Rock camp at **No Cost to the camper**.

Meals on Wheels

Volunteers deliver a nutritional meal, along with a wellness check and companionship Monday thru Friday in Prescott, Prescott Valley and Chino Valley.

Coyote Springs Elementary School

Helping with school supplies and teachers needs. Volunteers can work with students in the academic areas.

Agape House

Provides long term transitional housing for families who are without a residence. Agape House seeks to keep families together while helping facilitate additional support services in order to equip the families for an independent and self-sustained future."

Meals on Wheels

Delivering meals along with a wellness check and companionship to the homebound.

Prescott Area Shelter Services

Provides shelter and basic resources to homeless/transitional women and children of Yavapai County.

People Who Care

Volunteers provide caring non-medical assistance to adults unable to drive so that they can continue living on their own.

Habitat for Humanity

Brings people together to build homes in communities and hope for low income applicants for home ownership.

Highway Clean up

Parish members give back to the community by volunteering to clean a section of Highway 89 between St. Luke's and Chino Valley (markers 323-325) that is assigned to St. Luke's.

Vet's Undie Sunday

New underwear and socks along with clothing, pillows and sleeping bags are collected for Veteran military men and women.

Prison Ministry

In collaboration with the Daughters of the King personal Birthday cards and Christmas cards are sent to women in Perryville Prison.

Blood Drive

Blood drives are held several times a year in cooperation with Vitalant.

Eyeglass Collection

Supports the Lions Club in their outreach to those in need of specific medical needs.

Cell Phone Collection

Old and unwanted cell phones are collected year-round with proceeds helping women in crisis.
