Recipients will be announced **Sunday, May 17, 2026,** at the 10:00 am service at St. Luke's Episcopal Church. Scholarship checks will only be made payable to the school following enrollment and must be issued in the year they are awarded.

Eligibility

Student must be a full-time high school senior attending high school in the Quad City area. Student must have applied to and will attend an accredited vocational or trade school after high school graduation.

Requirements

- A minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0.
- Student must plan to attend an accredited vocational or trade school after high school graduation.
- Student must answer the essay question.
- Student must complete the application.
- Finalists will be interviewed by Scholarship Committee members.
- Deadline for submission to St. Luke's Episcopal Church is Thursday, March 5, 2026.

Selection of Scholarship Recipients

St. Luke's independent Scholarship Committee will review all applications and select up to three (3) \$1,000 scholarship winners. Winners will be notified by phone or email the week before the announcement at church so that they can prepare to receive their scholarship awards at the 10:00 am service at St. Luke's on **Sunday, May 17, 2026**. The scholarships will **not** be based on financial need but on the quality of the application, written essay, and interview.

Along with the completed application, the student must also submit:

- Official school transcript or high school equivalency certificate (GED).
- Three (3) letters of recommendation, one of which must be from a school counselor or a teacher. No relatives.
- Verification of acceptance to an accredited vocational or trade school.
